Nomination Procedure

As it was adopted at the May 9th, 2012 APPA General Assembly, the union no longer sends the election documents to individual members at home. Since 2013, all documents pertaining to the General Assembly in which elections will be held are to be made available on the APPA website.

Any member wishing to run as a candidate for the positions available in the upcoming elections must consult the "Elections" section of the APPA website at www.appa.qc.ca. This section contains the "Election Guide," which includes all information related to the elections as well as the nomination form.

Only the original ballot signed by the candidate and initialed by three witnesses who are members in good standing of the APPA will be accepted. It must be returned by mail, by email, or delivered in person to the Elections Secretary no later than ten days before the elections are held.

If the candidate chooses to submit the form by email, it must still include handwritten signatures from both the candidate and the witnesses. A scanned document is therefore required.



Registration Information for the General Assembly

Members attending this election General Assembly must complete the Microsoft Forms form provided for this purpose.

The form is accessible using the QR code below or through the following registration link.

Registration will be open from Tuesday, September 8, 2026, at 8:00 a.m., following the Labour Day holiday, until Friday, September 25, 2026 at 12:00 p.m. (noon).

When registering, members must enter the four-digit number corresponding to their class of employment.
