



Sectorial negotiations - School sector FEESP-CSN

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Management's new submission

Under the pretext of advancement in the negotiations, management submits demands that include additional rollbacks!

Management's negotiating committees for both the francophone service centres and anglophone school boards called a meeting with the union for October 22nd and 23rd, whereby it submitted an amended booklet of its demands, they say, as a means of taking a step forward to arrive at a rapid conclusion to the negotiations. The main objective of this approach: impose new rollbacks to the disability plans and salary insurance plans, and this in the throes of a full-blown pandemic

As such, these new booklets of demands are now more imposing than the original ones. These new demands do not appear in management's prioritized booklets, which were submitted last spring. Therefore, it is evident that they brought back those demands from their original booklets, submitted in December 2019, whereby such demands attacked those on disability or having suffered an employment injury.

Additionally, management has the utter gall to ask the FEESP-CSN school sector negotiating committee to withdraw their demands, while they have increased theirs.

While the support staff have lived and are (still) living the most exceptional back to school season and the psychological and physical fatigue is omnipresent in all spheres, management is taking advantage and trying to obtain rollbacks in the disability plans. This is a blatant lack of recognition!

We must clearly demonstrate to employers that their requests do not pass!
