#### Welcome Back

As September approaches its end, it is hard to believe that the summer holidays went by so quickly. The APPA executive welcomes you back and we hope that you were able to slow down, enjoy time with your loved ones and recharge your batteries.

This year promises to be an eventful one. Not only will we be holding a strike vote in September and hosting a BBQ & bowling event for national support staff day, but there will also be general assemblies to vote in our 1st Vice-president and to renew our collective insurance. Combined with our continued pressure tactics, we will be hard at work to make sure our union stays strong!

#### Why are we Having our Strike Vote General Assembly in Person?

The APPA is very aware of the convenience of having general assemblies online. Most of our members live in the east or the west and is it difficult to travel to the other side of the city for a 7:00 p.m. meeting. A request was made by the APPA executive to hold the general assembly with our strike vote online. Unfortunately, it was not possible for this meeting.

The last strike vote was online because we were in a pandemic and not legally allowed to gather in large numbers. We had to read statements and vote, that given the extreme circumstances, the general assembly would be held online, exceptionally.

Since the law requires us to hold a strike vote by secret ballot, it also meant spending tens of thousands of dollars to use a specific third-party voting system that could verify the identity of each voter and maintain the confidentiality of the vote.

We are governed by the labour code, our by-laws, and our internal regulations. However, to change our by-laws, there would have to be a notice of motion made at a regular general assembly by a member. Our next regular joint meeting (CSSDM & EMSB) will be on October 25<sup>th</sup>. Once the notice of motion is made, it gets put on the agenda for the members to debate and vote at the following general assembly.

The APPA gets many calls regarding the breaks and lunch periods to which our members are entitled. Taking a breather from our busy schedules is important for our well-being. Our collective agreement states the following:

6 to 8 HOUR WORK SHIFT	<ul> <li>15-minute morning rest period, which shall be taken towards the middle of the morning period.</li> <li>Lunch break towards the middle of the workday</li> <li>15-minute afternoon rest period, which shall be taken towards the middle of the afternoon period.</li> </ul>
MORE THAN 5 HOURS, BUT LESS THAN 6 HOURS	15-minute morning rest period, which shall be taken towards the middle of the morning period.  Lunch break towards the middle of the workday
3 to 5 HOUR WORK SHIFT	15-minute morning rest period, which shall be taken towards the middle of the work shift. No lunch break.

Please note that employees are not permitted to forego their rest periods in order to accumulate overtime compensation or reduce their workday.

# Calling in sick? Have an appointment? Need someone to fill in for you? Whose responsibility is it to find my replacement?

If you cannot be at work, it is your responsibility to let your immediate supervisor know that you will be absent. Though you may be willing to find your own replacement, it is not your responsibility. This applies to all APPA members, whether in the general sector, special educator sector, or the daycare sector.

#### **School Delegates for 2023-2024**

As every school year begins, the hunt for school delegates or liaisons has become a main priority, especially this fall.

We need <u>at least one person</u> per workplace to distribute union gear, for strike attendance, membership cards signatures, amongst other tasks.

It is especially important this year because in the case of a strike, members will not have access to the strike fund if there is not someone in place to coordinate the attendance sheets. The union executive cannot be in all workplaces at the same time and that is why we need to rely on the help of the delegate or liaison.

Eastern Orthodox Christmas	January 7, 2024 (falls on a Sunday)
Feast of The Annunciation	March 25, 2024
Orthodox Easter	May 3, 2024 (Good Friday)
EID-AL-FITR	April 10, 2024
EID-AL-ADHA	June 17, 2024

Any additional dates, as well as requests made by employees of other faiths, should be verified with the Human Resources Department.

Any Religious Holidays that fall on the weekend <u>will not be compensated on a work day</u>.

#### Need a break! Time for a vacation! When can I take time off?

We often get questions from members about taking time off during the school year. For 12-month employees, there is a procedure for booking their vacation time. However, for 10-month employees, taking any vacation time outside of March Break is not normally allowed since the vacation days are paid out in the summer (we are all off during the Christmas Holidays, so that period does not count).

There are some special leaves permitted according to our collective agreement, including time off for one's marriage, deaths in the family and moving. The complete list can be found in Chapter 5 of our collective agreement.

Any other request for leave must be approved by your immediate supervisor <u>and</u> Human Resources. A request for a leave of absence must be done in a timely manner, providing the reason in most cases. Approval of your leave is subject to the EMSB's discretion.
