Why didn't I get a raise this year?

Our 2015-2020 Collective Agreement officially expired on March 31, 2020. Until a new collective agreement is negotiated and signed, there is no salary increase given. However, the clauses of the 2015-2020 agreement remain in effect until a new Collective Agreement is signed.

Three Extra Pedagogical days and Holiday Extension?

The government recently announced the addition of three extra pedagogical days for the 2020-2021 school year. The FEESP-School Sector and the APPA are very aware of the serious impact these extra days may have on the employees affected by this decision. Since March, and throughout this pandemic, the government has required these employees to provide services without consulting

them or their unions, all the while neglecting to recognize their contribution.



For our part, the APPA had made representation to the EMSB to implement measures to mitigate work overload and stress levels. Discussions are currently taking place with respect to, among other issues, hours of work, preparation and planning, and staffing. We encourage our members to attend the general assembly and voice their concerns regarding these added days so that further representation and actions can take place, if necessary.

Like everyone else, the APPA learned of the potential extension of the holidays during Mr. Legault's news conference on Monday, November 18th. The FEESP-School Sector is already making representation with the government regarding this announcement. More details will follow as they become available.

Collective Agreement Information

Overtime Hours:

Anytime you are asked to work overtime, make sure you have it in writing. As the adage says: "A verbal agreement is only as good as the paper it is written on."

Personal Days:

Employees who are on automatic payroll are entitled to 2 days per year for personal matters. These days cannot be denied by the employer provided the request is made, in writing, at least 24 hours in advance. Personal days are taken from the 7-day sick bank.

Family Responsibility:

An employee may take up to 10 days off per year for family obligations related to health, care or education. Up to 6 of these days can be paid from the employee's unused sick days.

Special Leaves:
