The school sector employees will be called upon, in the coming weeks, to take a position on the tentative agreements in principle from the sectoral and central negotiating tables.

Reunited during the assemblies held on the 4th and 5th of January, the school sector delegates voted to accept the tentative agreements in principle from the sectoral and <u>central tables</u>, which were presented to them by their negotiating committees. The two hypotheses, which must be considered as a whole since they will form your next collective agreement, will be presented to you at a general assembly. You, the support staff we represent, will have the final say. We therefore invite you to attend in large numbers, so that we can answer all your questions.

As a matter of fact, this present round of negotiations will officially end once the working conditions & practices, as well as salary conditions will be judged satisfactory by the 420,000 employees grouped together under the Common Front banner. Therefore, you will be called upon to take position on the proposed global agreement during the consultation tours which be held between mid-January and the end of February. Stay abreast of the news from your union, so as to obtain the details of your general assembly.

Throughout these negotiations our mandate, as your negotiating committee, has been to obtain meaningful gains for every category of employment that we represent. And, throughout these negotiations, we sat before a government whose only wish was to speak about its priorities. Therefore, we had to work relentlesssly to impose ours. This was only possible because of your historic mobilisation, by being active in the field for more than a year by making our union demands known.
